**Can I still reserve a room?**

We have met our deadline for the hotel block; however, the hotel is still offering the group rate for a short time. If you did not reserve a room and would like a room at Paris, please contact Lauren Rich at [Lrich@crs.com](mailto:Lrich@crs.com).

**How do I get to the hotel?**

If you are flying, you will arrive in Las Vegas at McCarran International Airport, which is 15 minutes from the hotel. Once you arrive at the airport, you will collect your baggage and exit the terminal. The taxi line is right outside of arrivals. The line seems like it never ends; however, it usually moves pretty quickly. If several of you are in line and find that you are going to the Paris, you can work out a deal with one of the Limo drivers to take you to the hotel as cheaply as a taxi.

When departing the hotel to get back to the airport, be sure to allow enough time. Once you arrive to the airport you will have to go through security and board a tram to your departure terminal; this sometimes takes 45 minutes or more. Be sure to check with the hotel staff as they will be in the know for how much time you need.

**Can I be reached at Paris?**

Family, coworkers and friends can reach you at the Paris Las Vegas if you have reservations at the hotel. If you are not holding a reservation at the hotel, the quickest way for someone to reach you will most likely be your personal cell phone.

**Should I check my registration?**

Yes! Do not wait to make sure that everything is correct on your confirmation received from the Council. It is so easy to key in the wrong arrival or spell a name incorrectly. Please verify the following details to assure a trouble free check-in.

1. Is your name spelled correctly?
2. Are your arrival and departure dates correct?
3. Is your city and state correct? Is it spelled correctly?
4. Are your accommodations as requested?
